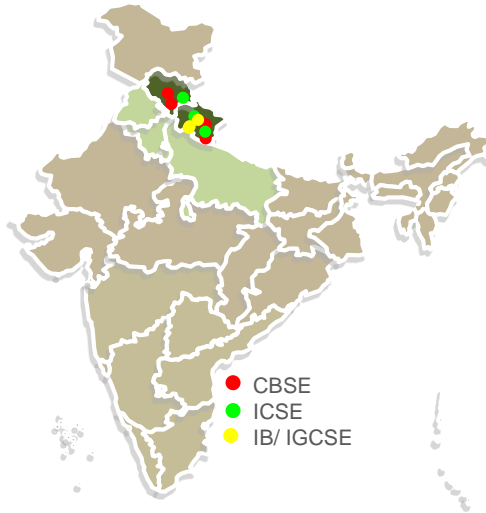

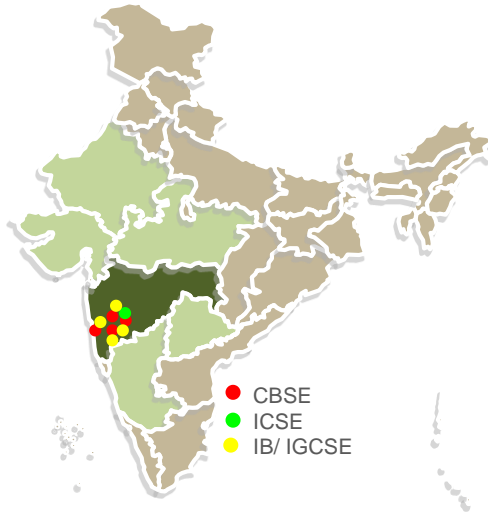

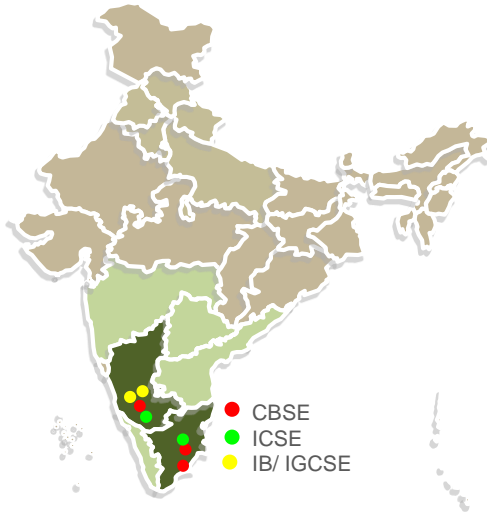

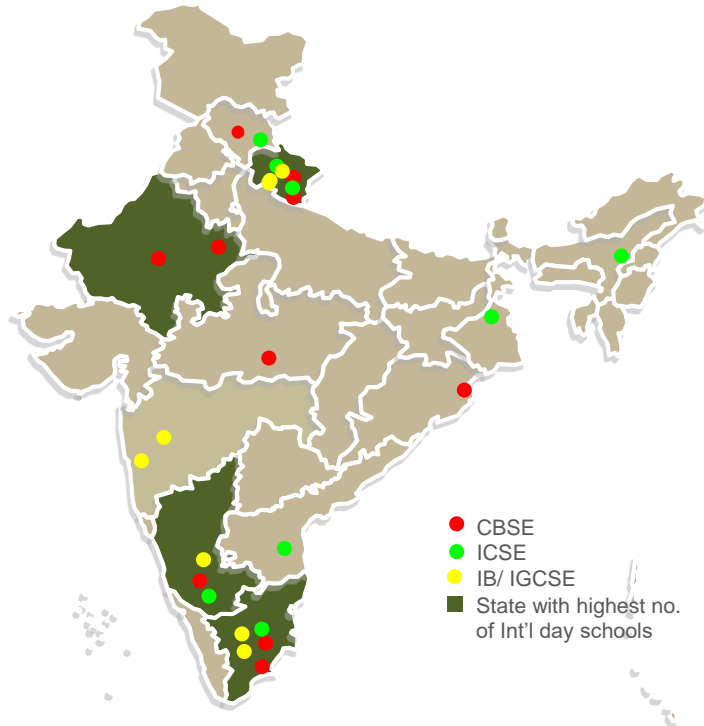

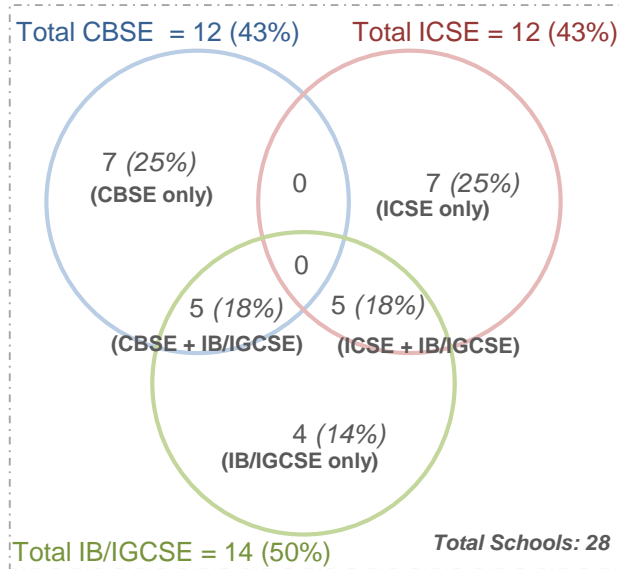

Key Highlights:

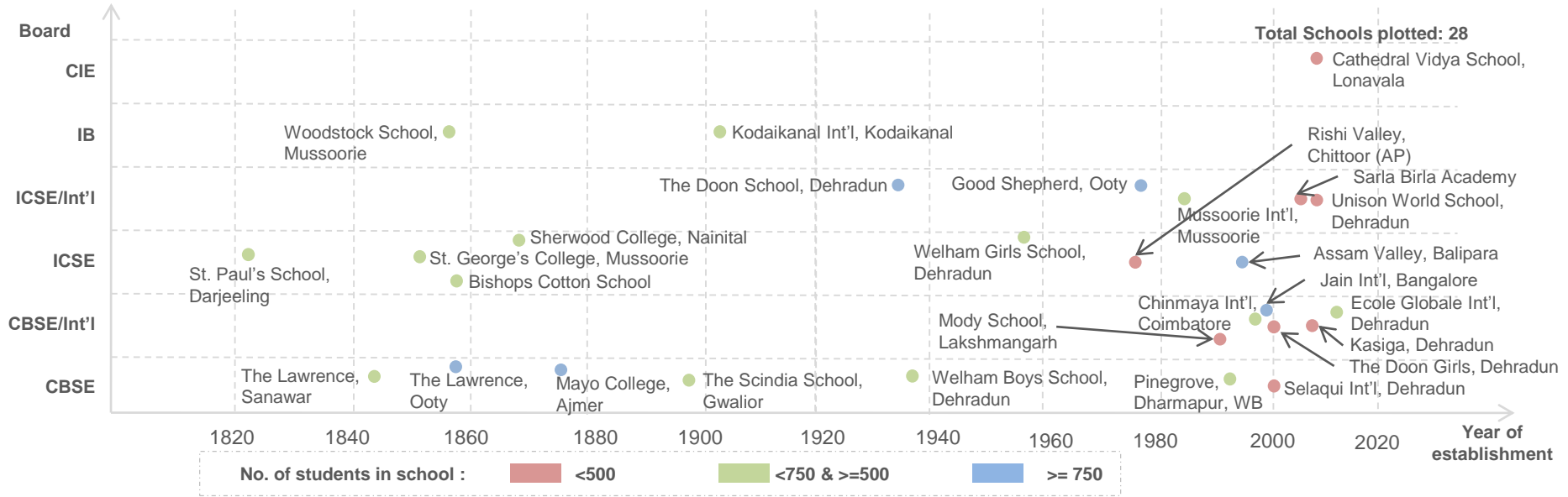
- 50% (14) of the selected 28 top boarding schools are affiliated to International Curriculum
- Out of the 14 International Schools:
 - Dual Board Schools (CBSE +IB/IGCSE or ICSE + IB/IGCSE) are more prominent in comparison to standalone (IB/IGCSE only) schools

Key Highlights:

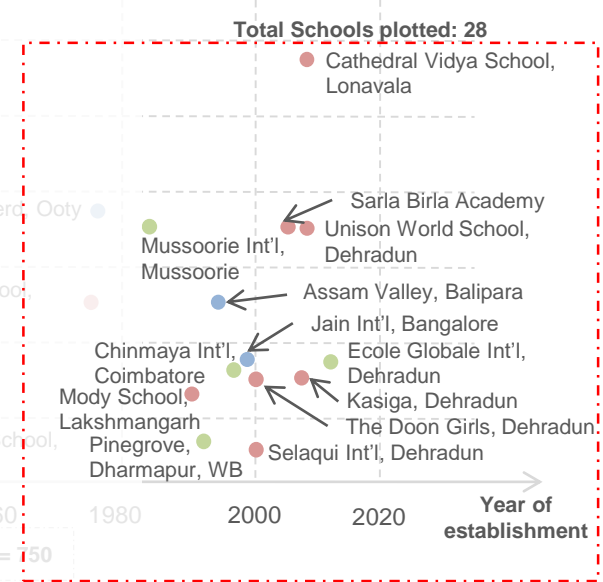
- The schools established during the colonial rule follow National Curricula (CBSE/ICSE) and are filled to their peak capacity
- However, it was observed that the schools set up post 1999, follow both International as well as National Curricula
- CBSE coupled with International Curricula is the most preferred combination post 1999 (67%) with highest strength

Affiliation Board: 'Establishment year vs. Strength'...(3/3)

Total 28 boarding schools are analyzed below based on their establishment year and strength :

- Post 1980, it was observed, the schools started to have multiple affiliation (National and International)
- 38% schools have good enrolment (5 schools have more than 500 students)
